He oversees the Strategic Services divisions including both the Health Information Systems and the Strategic Policy and Performance divisions, as well as the System Refocusing division.

In his base role, Matt is the Assistant Deputy Minister of System Refocusing at Alberta Primary and Preventative Health Services. The System Refocusing Division is responsible for leading the Department's critical work on supporting and implementing the health system refocusing, including standing up provincial health agencies, coordinating work within the Department, government and with key stakeholders, and ensuring a smooth transition for the health care system.

Previously, Matt served as Assistant Deputy Minister System Excellence at Education. In that role, he was responsible for teacher certification, leadership development, and provincial assessments. He led the implementation of the new teacher and teacher leader professional discipline model and the launch of the new provincial assessment digital platform. Previously, he was an executive director at Indigenous Relations, Transportation,
